## American Heroes Presentation Student Rubric

### Content (5 points each)

- You know your topic very well.
- You have informed the visitors with lots of interesting information.

### Delivery (5 points each)

- Your presentation is very smooth and orderly.
- You are not reading your presentation.
- You are making good eye contact with your audience.

### Visuals (45 points total)

- Your poster board is attractive and reflects effort and quality work. (Quality work means that it looks as if you have really spent a month to do your project). (5 points)
- You are dressed as your hero. (10 pts)

### Your poster board must include:

- At least 2 pictures or drawings.
- The name of your hero.
- Where your hero lived.
- A short paragraph (3-5 sentences) explaining what makes your 'hero' a hero to you.
- A brief summary of important events in your Hero's life.
- Birth & death dates/places (if applicable). (5 points each)

### Hero mini-book (30 points total)

#### Your book must include the following:

- Childhood (what it was like, as well as their birthplace & date of it). (5 points)
- What were the times like when they lived? (lifestyles, where they lived, who was the president at the time...). (5 points)
- Struggles in their life (Problems they overcame, their education level). (5 points)
- Main accomplishment(s) in life (What they are famous for). (5 points)
- Mechanics (spelling, punctuation, overall neatness, etc). (10 points)
